

## English

## Maths

Learn multiplication and division facts for tables up to 12x12. Read and write numbers up to 10,000. Compare and order whole numbers up to 1000. Add and subtract 10, 100 and 1000. Add and subtract 3 and 4-digit numbers using written methods (including column addition and subtraction.) Multiply and divide by 10 and 100. Finding the perimeter of a 2D shape. Calculate and compare area. Identify angles. Read and plot co-ordinates.

## Science

Electricity: To construct simple circuits, identify components, recognise that switches open and close circuits, and investigate good insulators and conductors.

States of Matter: Group and classify materials as solids, liquids and gases. Investigating 'change of state' in melting and freezing. Learn about condensation and evaporation studying the water cycle.

## Geography

A study of Europe to include the cities as well as the mountain ranges and rivers. With a special emphasis in Greece, to compare the human and physical geography of Greece and England.

## Art

### Self Portraits

To explore the artist Sandra Silberzweig to create self portraits focusing on emotions depicted as colour.

## DT

Design and make a Christmas toy including the use of circuits.

## PSHCE

Aspects of internet safety. Learning to love and appreciate oneself, encouraging self belief. Consider all the aspects of health which promote a healthy mind. To consider how their behaviour might effect others.

## French

To learn numbers up to 20. To use names for family members and to describe them verbally and in simple sentences using simple colour and size adjectives.

## PE

Rugby: learning to play with tactics and strategies whilst developing fundamental skills

Golf – Following skills based lessons, the children will explore and develop their accuracy of aiming at a target.

Fitness: Self challenged activities to increase their cardio and stamina over the course of the term.

## Computing

They will then create their own database. Using scratch the children will write a sequence of statements to execute a program using repetition and conditional statements.

## RE

What do Hindus believe that God is like? Identify some Hindu deities and ways in which Hindus worship. Make links between the Hindu idea of everyone having a 'spark' of God in them. What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today? Describe how Hindus show their faith within their families/ faith communities in Britain today. Make links between Hindu practices and the idea that Hinduism is a whole 'way of life'.
