Prefects

This year, we have introduced an additional level of responsibility in Year 6: **School Prefect**. It is considered to be a prestigious position with expectation that children would lead by example, be relied upon to have an excellent attitude to their learning and demonstrate our school values at all times.

A School Prefect will have a variety of responsibilities through the year, working on a rotation basis each term.

Prefect roles and responsibilities will include:

- Lunchtime Mentors
- Organising and leading lunchtime games
- Working with staff to ensure play equipment is well stocked
- Organising Litter Picking
- Showing visitors around the school
- Corridor monitoring: encouraging children to move around the school calmly and quietly
- Working with classes during wet break / lunch times
- Assisting at school fairs and events

Prefects will not be expected to carry out all of these duties at all times; they may be asked to assist House Captains and School Council members for some, but they will be involved in the organising and, where necessary, delegating of these tasks to other pupils and being involved in the day to day organisation of the school.
