Year 4 National Roman Legion Museum Trip - Thursday 19th March 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have arranged a trip to go to **The National Roman Legion Museum in Newport** on **Thursday 19th March 2026**, as part of our History topic on the Romans. During the trip the children will visit the Roman Museum, amphitheatre, baths and barracks. They will have the opportunity try on replica Roman armour in a reconstructed Barrack Room and see how Roman soldiers lived. We will also take part in a facilitated workshop with a costumed Roman expert at the museum. This promises to be an exciting and memorable experience, allowing the children to learn first-hand about how the Romans lived.

We will be leaving school at **8.45am**, so all children need to be **at school for 8.30am**. The children should come through the main entrance via the school office at this time. We expect to return to school at approximately **3.30pm**.

Children will need to bring a **packed lunch, snacks and drink**, all contained in a **small bag or rucksack**. They will need to wear **school uniform** and as most of the activities are outdoors, please bring appropriate outdoor clothing, such as a **waterproof coat and comfortable shoes**.

We are asking for **£11.25** to cover the cost of the trip. Please make payments using your Parentpay account by **Sunday 1st March 2026**.

Although a voluntary contribution is requested, we need to stress that unless there is sufficient interest and willingness to contribute towards the cost, the activities will not be able to go ahead.

For those families in receipt of Free School Meals, the funding will cover the cost of this trip for your child. However, we would ask you to access your Parentpay account in order for you to give consent for your child to go on this trip.
