Egyptian Cinderella and Butterfly Lion:

The children will read an alternative fairy tale with a focus on sentence structure. They will apply their sentence skills to a variety of different pictures from the story, with a focus on editing and improving their choice of vocabulary.

Science

Lights and Shadow

Identify light sources.

- Understand that we need light to see.
- Know that light travels in a straight line.
- Identify reflective surfaces.
- Know that the Sun can damage their eyes.
- Know how to protect their eyes from the Sun.
- Understand that a shadow is formed when a solid object blocks light.

Investigations

Focusing on the skills required to carry out scientific investigations.

Music

Children will listen to a range of rag and tal music, identifying traditional instruments as well as creating their own improvisations and performing as a class.

Maths

Fractions: tenths, counting in tenths, comparing, equivalence, addition & subtraction and finding fractions of amounts.

Time: ¼ & ½ past, months, years and hours, am/pm & 24hour clock, time to the minute.

Shapes: angles, types of lines, 2D & 3D shapes & their properties.

Measure: measure, compare, add & subtract mass & capacity.

Geography

Children will learn human and physical geography of Burnham-on-Sea and compare this to Benhall.

History

Ancient Egypt

We will be learning about Ancient Egypt starting around 7,500BC to 30AD. Children will be focusing on the importance of the pyramids and what we can learn from how they were built to the things that were inside.

French

Children will learn how to describe a variety of objects and places that are familiar to them within school.

DT

Children will investigate, plan and create their own Egyptian pyramid utilising skills from maths to build 3D structures.

PSHCE

The children will be continuing with using Zones of Regulation to recognise their emotions. Once complete, they will move onto a programme called: Socially Speaking

Art

We will be studying the colourful and vibrant work of Edward Tingatinga and the movement he left behind.

PE

Athletics – skipping, hopping, jumping, throwing, catching, sprinting, relay racing.

Tennis – Developing the key skills such as the ready position, racket control and hitting a ball. They learn how to score points and how to use skills, simple strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.
