### Curriculum Map

#### English

##### Writing to inform

Newspaper report based on an alien invasion.  
Non-chronological report based on the animal kingdoms in science.

##### Writing to entertain

Writing a narrative that includes character and setting description based upon a short animation.

Class reader – Melt

#### Art

To show how the work of an artist was influential in both society and to other artists. Create pieces of work inspired by Banksy.

#### Science

##### All Living Things

Sort and classify groups of plants and animals based on their features using the Linnaean system. Set up an investigation into harmful microorganisms and describe the useful and harmful effects.

##### Investigations

Carrying out a variety of experiments, across a broad range of Science topics. Results will be presented in a number of forms.

#### PE

##### Hockey

Children will be able to dribble, pass, receive and shoot the ball with increasing control, under pressure.

##### Swimming

For those that it applies, children will be developing skills to be safe in the water and work towards swimming 25m.

##### Out Door and Adventurous (for those not swimming)

Developing active and team building skills.

##### Cricket

Children will be able to strike a bowled ball with increasing consistency and accuracy.

#### RE

##### Why do Hindus want to be good?

Identifying, explaining and making clear connections between Hindu beliefs, e.g. dharma, karma, samsara and moksha and ways in which Hindus live.

##### What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?

Outline the timeline of the 'big story' of the Bible, exploring how incarnation and Salvation fit within it.

Make clear connections between the Christian belief in Jesus' death as a sacrifice and how Christians celebrate Holy Communion.

#### PSHCE

##### Too Much Selfie Isn't Healthy

Empathy. Exploring the importance of others and how to love them well. Too Much Selfie isn't Healthy is about working well with others, about being a good listener and understanding that life is more about we than me. Love without action isn't love, it's a thought. Love requires an out; love does. By contributing to the lives of others we find fulfilment for ourselves and learn that Too Much Selfie isn't Healthy!

##### Don't Rub it in, Rub it Out!

Forgiveness. Learn how to process negative emotions, disappointment and hurt. Don't Rub it in, Rub it Out! means choosing to forgive, leaving the pointing finger in our pocket and accepting that we too need grace just as much as we give it away. Everyone makes mistakes. Don't demand perfection, instead celebrate progress, that's what love does.

#### Geography

##### Global Trade

Children will understand what trade is and how countries rely on each other when importing and exporting goods. There will be a particular focus on food and the impacts of trade.

#### Music

**Musical Theatre:** children will understand the components and the roles that make up a performance. They will then plan their own scene incorporating these components.

#### Computing

##### iApp Unit 1

This unit extends the children's app development skills from block-based programming by introducing them to programming apps with text. Using a simplified JavaScript language, the children apply their computational thinking skills and begin to understand the importance of syntax in programming.

##### Micro:bits

Children will use the design that they create to make a micro:bit-based step counter.

##### E-Safety

Using ProjectEVOLVE, a free digital literacy toolkit that supports online development in children and young people, we will have weekly sessions educating, guiding and supporting the children through their use of technology in their online life. The toolkit establishes some of the fundamental building blocks around the right sort of education needed for their online development and wellbeing.

#### French

**Food and drink.** Conversational French to use in a French cafe. Focusing upon the vocabulary for food and drink as well as ordering and giving preferences.
