Year 4 Cheltenham Tour Trip – Thursday 25th June 2026

Dear Parents,

On **Thursday 25th June**, Y4 will be doing a walking tour of Cheltenham. This will encompass some geography fieldwork on the land and building use along Montpellier Street, as well as looking at the features of historic development on buildings, linked to our topic on how Cheltenham has grown over time. We will also be visiting Wilson Art Gallery, where the children will be finding out more about Wilson the explorer and the Antarctic landscape.

The children will need to be in uniform, but should wear a comfortable pair of trainers as we are walking from Montpellier to Pittville Park. They will need a backpack, to carry their packed lunch and drink in, and depending on the weather must bring a raincoat/coat in case of rain, or suncream/sun hat, as we will be outside all day.

The cost of the trip is £4.15 and covers the cost of the coach and Art Gallery tour. Please make payments using your Parentpay account by **Monday 8th June**.

Although a contribution is requested, we need to stress that unless there is sufficient interest and willingness to contribute towards the cost, the activities will not be able to go ahead.

For those families in receipt of Free School Meals, the funding will cover the cost of this trip for your child. However, we would ask you to access your Parentpay account in order for you to give consent for your child to go on this trip.
